He grades within a day or two of the test and responds to emails within minutes. He s pretty good.

Professor Guy is not only one of the best teachers but one of the best math educators from whom I have ever had the privilege of learning. Guy takes his time with the material and never takes short cuts. What is more his lectures are always well thought out detailed and decisive. Strikingly he successfully avoids the pitfall of making mistakes in class and confusing students with frequent backstepping erasing and re-explanations. Guy definitely discourages memorization of formulas rather he emphasizes understanding the mechanisms at work that lead to the formulas. He always encourages questions in and outside of class and opens the forum for anonymous opinions and critics through our class blog. Finally and most importantly he is an extremely accessible and dedicated professor. I have contacted him at odd hours during the week and on weekends and received a prompt response. He was always available during office hours and often was willing to meet with me when I could not make them. He also offered his time on a Sunday evening to hold a review session before our mid-term for both calculus sections.
